



All Hong Kong Schools Jing Ying Badminton Tournament 2017-2018 (Secondary Schools Section) 2017-2018年度全港學界精英羽毛球比賽 (中學組)



【 General Rules 】

The All Hong Kong Schools Jing Ying Badminton Tournament 2017–2018 is organized by the Hong Kong Schools Sports Federation, and subvented by the Leisure and Cultural Services Department.

1. Competition Schedule :

10/11/2017 (Fri)	0900 – 1600	Po Kong Village Road Sports Centre (蒲崗村道公園體育館)	Final Round

2. Eligibility of Participants :

- 2.1 Participating schools must be the registered members of HKSSF in 2017–2018.
- 2.2 All participants must be registered students of HKSSF in 2017–2018.
- 2.3 All participants must be born on or after 1 January 1999.

3. Competition System :

- 3.1 Two categories : Boys and Girls; Two events : Singles and Doubles;
- 3.2 Knock-out system for all events;
- 3.3 In preliminary round to top 16, matches will be played to the best of one game. Top 8 to final, matches will be played to the best of 3 games. Each game should be 21 points as adopted by the Hong Kong Badminton Association.
- 3.4 Position matches for 3rd to 8th places will be introduced.

4. Awards :

- 4.1 Trophies will be awarded to top 8 winners of singles event and doubles event in each category.
- 4.2 All winners should be awarded with certificates.

5. Entry Fee :

- 5.1 \$100.00 per participant in singles event
- 5.2 \$100.00 per pair in doubles event

6. Important Date:

- 6.1 **Deadline of Entries : 3 October 2017 (Tuesday)**
- 6.2 **Confirmation of Entries : 9 October (Monday)**
Accepted entries will be uploaded to the website of the HKSSF (www.hkssf.org.hk) for checking. Schools should check the Participating List carefully to ensure all entries are included and the names of competitors are correct. Discrepancies must be reported to the Federation on or before 12 October at 12:00 noon.
- 6.3 **Lots Drawing for seeding (Tentative) : 16 October 2017 (Monday)**
The lots drawing will held at the Federation office, all participating schools are welcomed to inspect the draw.
- 6.4 **Competition Fixtures (Tentative): 19 October 2017 (Thursday)**
Competition fixtures, reporting time will be uploaded to the website of the HKSSF. **Participating schools please download fixtures from the web.**

7. Entries :

- 7.1 Each participating school may enter a maximum of 4 players including 2 in singles event and 1 team in doubles event. **Players can play in EITHER the Singles, OR the Doubles event.**
- 7.2 Schools should download the entry form from the HKSSF website (www.hkssf.org.hk) → 【Jing Ying, Interport and Overseas Competitions】 → 【Jing Ying Tournaments】 → 【Badminton】 → 【Entry Form】 (Excel Format). Completed form should be sent to external@hkssf.org.hk before the deadline of entries. Please refer the details on the separate circular 'E-Application Procedure'.
- 7.3 Completed entry form should be printed with Principal's Signature and School Chop and posted back before the deadline of entries with the entry fee (with a crossed cheque payable to "**Hong Kong Schools Sports Federation**") to :

- 7.4 **No entry will be entertained after the deadline of entries.**
- 7.5 All participating schools should confirm received of their entries and cheque by calling at 2768 8212 two working days after posting. HKSSF would not be liable to any missing mail.
- 7.6 Substitution of participants will not be considered after the deadline of entries.

8. Seeding :

Results of the All HK Schools Jing Ying Tournament 2016-2017 and the Open & Youth Competitions 2017 of HKBA will be considered. Participants should provide details of the related results in the entry form. Entry forms with incompleted information will not be considered. For all seeding arrangement, HKSSF Badminton Technical and Selection Subcommittee have full rights to make final decision. (For details, please refer to HKSSF Secondary General Information Booklet ~ Jing Ying Tournaments)

9. Others :

- 9.1 HKBA rules will be adopted unless otherwise specified.
- 9.2 Apart from the above mentioned, other rules and regulations will be followed with reference to the Secondary Schools General Information Booklet 2017-2018 issued by the Hong Kong Island & Kowloon Regional Committee and the New Territories Regional Committee.
- 9.3 Shuttlecocks (**Hi-Qua Blue Label**) will be provided for competition.
- 9.4 Uniform
 - 9.4.1 All athletes must wear appropriate sportswear when participating in the competition.
 - 9.4.2 Athletes are required to wear their uniform tops bearing school name / abbreviation / badge, which should be sewn, stenciled or marked on permanently.
 - 9.4.3 It is not necessary for all players to dress in identical uniform with same colour and same style.
 - 9.4.4 Uniform must not contain any slogans or advertising with indecent information, such as gambling, tobacco, spirits, political, and any discriminative, abusive, or unethical statements.
- 9.5 All participants must report at venue 30 minutes before the scheduled time. Failing to play at the scheduled time will lead to a walk-over.
- 9.6 Participants MUST present his/her valid HKSSF Student Registration Card 2017-2018 WHEN REPORTING. Failing of which, he/she will be disqualified.
- 9.7 **With effect from 2017-2018 season, The Hong Kong Schools Sports Federation will launch a new Student Athletes Online Registration System. The new System will substitute the existing paper registration, which assists teachers to register student athletes in an effective and timely manner, and prevent typos/repeat registration. Details please refer to the HKSSF website "Student Athletes Online Registration System."**

- 9.8 Due to disciplinary and safety measures, each participant school should assign a staff member or an authorized Team Manager (Non-staff member) [The authorized Team Manager (Non-staff member) must be registered 3 days before the scheduled competition] to accompany the participants until the end of the competitions and he/she should take full responsibility of the conduct of the participants and their supporters both on and off the courts.
- 9.9 Entry receipts and athlete certificates will be posted within a month after the Tournament finishes.
- 9.10 The Organizing Committee has full right to make amendments on any matters when necessary.
