2. Competition system:

1st Stage : 16-19 December 2022

- Both Boys' and Girls' groups with 24 teams are allotted into 6 groups by lots draw, with 4 teams in each group.
- Playing in a single round-robin format, with 12 team (the top two teams in each group) advancing to the next stage.

[The 2nd stage lots draw for the Boys' group will be held at Tung Cheong Street S.C. on 19th December at **7:30 pm**, while the lots draw for the Girls' group will be held at Tung Cheong Street Sports Centre on 19 December at 5:00 p.m.]

2nd Stage: 21-23 December 2022

- Both Boys' and Girls' groups with 12 teams are allotted into 4 groups by lot draws with 3 teams in each group.
- Playing in a single round-robin format, with 8 team (the top two teams in each group) advancing to the knockout phase.

[The lots draw for the quarter-finals of both Boys' and Girls' group will be held at Tiu Keng Leng Sports Centre at 1:00 pm on 23rd December.]

Final stage :

Quarter-finals : 24th December 2022

- Single Knock-out format

Semi-Finals : 4th February 2023 (The stop clock system will be adopted starting from semi-finals).

- Semi-Finals , Winner will advance to Finals, Loser will compete for 3rd Places

Finals : 5th February 2023

- Determine 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th Places

3. Unless otherwise stipulated, all matches will be performed in accordance with the rules set by the Hong Kong Basketball Association.

4. Other rules and arrangements will be implemented in accordance with the general rules and basketball game rules in the 2022-2023 Hong Kong, Kowloon and New Territories Secondary School Sports Competition Booklet issued by the HKSSF.
 5. This Tournament will be contested in Open Grades. Participating schools can send Grade A, Grade B and Grade C students with HKSSF athlete registration cards to participate in the Tournament.
 6. Participating schools must report to the HKSSF 20 minutes before the game time set and fill out the player list. 12 players are allowed to register for each game. Failure to start the game on time will result in a walkover.
 7. Participating students must present the **2022-2023** valid athlete registration card issued by the HKSSF to the referees before the competition, otherwise they will not be able to participate in the Tournament.
 8. Once the match has started, the completed roster cannot be replaced.
 9. The game will use Nike basketball as the game ball, size No.7 for Boys and size No. 6 for Girls. 3 basketballs will be provided to team for warm up.
 10. Referees will be appointed by the HKSSF. The ruling on technical matters by the referee on that day shall be final.
 11. The information of the 14 players provided by your school will be uploaded on the official website of the Tournament. HKSSF accepts replacement of players at semi-finals stage on or before 13 January, 2023 (Friday).
 12. Prizes:
 - 12.1 The top four in Boys' and Girls' groups will each receive team trophies (one trophy), medals (16 pcs) and certificates (14 pcs).
 - 12.2 Individual Awards :
 - "Most Valuable Player" with one boy and one girl will be selected by the basketball technical and selection sub-committee members in the final round, and the winner will receive a Trophy.
 - "All-Star Team", with 8 Boys and 8 Girls each, will be selected by the basketball technical and selection sub-committee members at the quarter-finals, and the winners will receive commemorative jerseys.
 - "Best Rookie" with one boy and one girl will be selected by the basketball technical and selection sub-committee members at the quarter-finals, and the winners will receive Trophy. Award-winning players must be born in 2006 or later and have not won individual awards before (since the 2015-2016 or later).
 - "Best Defensive Player" with one boy and one girl will be selected by the basketball technical and selection sub-committee members at the quarter-finals, and the winner will receive a Trophy.
 - Both Boys and girls have these four awards namely "Leader in Rebounds", "Leader in Assists", "Best 3-Point Shooter" and "Leader in Steals", it will be calculated based on average score of respective statistical data. Players need to play at least six games to win these Awards. **(TBC)**
 13. Participating teams must be accompanied by one Team Manager who is a full time staff member or an authorized member (non-staff member) appointed and registered with HKSSF, otherwise teams will not be allowed to participate in the Tournament. The Team Manager shall be responsible for the conduct of the athletes, students and supporters both on and off the field.
