(B) 香港學界代表隊賽事

每項賽事均由本會的技術及遴選小組在精英比賽或遴選比賽中揀選優秀運動員,組成香港學界代表隊參加比賽。有關遴選詳情,將稍後通知各會員學校。

(一) 四地學界埠際比賽

由福建、廣東、香港及澳門四地輪流主辦,共有八個中學比賽,包括田徑、羽毛球、籃球、越野跑、足球、游泳、乒乓球及排球。每年舉辦四項,2019年工作會議議決由2020年起,每年其中兩項比賽加入小學組賽事:

All Hong Kong Schools Jing Ying Tournaments and Hong Kong Schools Teams Competitions

(A) All Hong Kong Schools Jing Ying Tournaments

(1) Seeding Arrangement

- 1.1 <u>Table Tennis</u> (A maximum of 16 seeding positions / 8 seeding positions will be allotted to singles and doubles events respectively. The Table Tennis Technical and Selection Sub-committee reserves the right to make all final seeding decisions)
 - A) Singles Event according to the following sequence :
 - A1). Ranking top 8 positions of singles event from last year's Tournament.
 - A2). Ranking top 8 positions of singles event of Hong Kong Table Tennis Association (HKTTA) *
 - A3). Ranking 9th-16th positions of singles event from last year's Tournament.
 - A4). Ranking first 100 positions of singles event of HKTTA. *

Remarks: Players who belong to the same school will be allotted separately in upper and lower tiers by drawing lots.

B) <u>Doubles Event - according to the following sequence</u>:

- B1). If the doubles pairing is the same as last year (*Not applicable in 2022-2023 season*),
 - a) Ranking top 8 positions of doubles event from last year's Tournament.
 - b) Ranking first 50 positions in doubles event of HKTTA. *
- B2). If the doubles pairing is different from last year (the pairs with higher the total scores will be seeded first. If two or more pairings have the same score, the pairing with the highest individual score will be seeded.)
 - a) Ranking top 16 positions of singles event from last year's Tournament.
 - b) Ranking first 100 positions of singles event of HKTTA.*

Remarks: No seeding will be made if no teams meet these criteria.

- Note: 1) * Ranking of HKTTA Singles Event (U12)/Doubles Event (As of 1 September 2022).
 - 2) All participating schools are responsible for providing correct information and prove for seeding consideration while handing in the entry form. Lack of prove or incorrect entry data will be treated as forfeit of seeding position.
- 1.2 <u>Badminton</u> (A maximum of 16 seeding positions/8 seeding positions will be allotted to singles and doubles events respectively. The Badminton Technical and Selection Sub-committee reserves the right to make all final decision.)
 - A) Singles Event according to the following sequence:
 - A1). Ranking top 8 positions of singles event from last year's Tournament.
 - A2). Ranking 9th-16th positions of singles event from last year's Tournament.
 - A3). Ranking top 8 positions of singles event (Current year's Open Grade of Hong Kong Badminton Association (HKBA):
 - a). HK Annual Badminton Championships
 - b). HK Youth Badminton Championships

Remarks: Players who belong to the same school will be allotted separately in upper and lower tiers by drawing lots.

B) <u>Doubles Event - according to the following sequence</u>:

- B1). If the pairing is the same as last year: ranking top 8 positions of doubles event of last year's Tournament. (Not applicable in 2022-2023 season)
- B2). If the pairing is different from last year, will count the best results of :
 - a). <u>Both players ranking in top 8 positions in singles events of last year's Tournament.</u>
 - b). Ranking top 8 positions of doubles event (Same pairing of Current Year's Open Grade of HKBA):-
 - 1). HK Annual Badminton Championships
 - 2). HK Youth Badminton Championships

Remarks: No seeding will be made if no teams meet these criteria.

Note: All participating schools are responsible for providing correct information and prove for seeding consideration while handing in the entry form. Lack of prove or incorrect entry data will be treated as forfeit of seeding position.

(B) Hong Kong Schools Teams Competitions

Our Technical and Selection Sub-committee panels of each sport will select outstanding athletes from respective Jing Ying Tournaments, or by selection trials, to form the Hong Kong School Teams. Details of the selections will be notified to all member schools in due course.

(1) Schools Interport Competitions

Schools Interport Competitions is a reputable sport competition program between Fujian, Guangdong, Hong Kong and Macau. It is a biennial competition for secondary schools students with each year having 4 sports competing and each region being the host for one sport in every year. Sports include Athletics, Badminton, Basketball, Cross Country, Football, Swimming, Table Tennis and Volleyball. In 2019 Interport Meeting, it was resolved to include 2 primary sports each year starting from 2020.
