香港學界代表隊參與國際比賽的遴選機制

1 背景

- 1.1 香港學界體育聯會除積極推動本地學界體育事業外，亦致力提昇學界賽事水平及增進國際間的友誼，故香港學界代表隊每年均積極參與埠際、亞洲及全國中學生運動會。
- 1.2 聯會與廣東、福建及澳門建立了一個完善的埠際比賽體制。此每年一度的比賽包括八個中學體育項目（田徑、游泳、越野跑、籃球、羽毛球、足球、乒乓球及排球）。八個項目分兩年舉行，每年舉辦四項，並每年輪值由四個地區舉辦不同的比賽項目。
- 1.3 自回歸以後，聯會開始參與每三年一度的全國中學生運動會。
- 1.4 聯會屬於亞洲學界足球聯合會及亞洲中學生體育聯合會的會員，積極參與亞洲地區體育比賽。
- 1.5 聯會其下的對外體育委員會負責管理及籌辦埠際、國際性的體育比賽。

2 技術及遴選小組

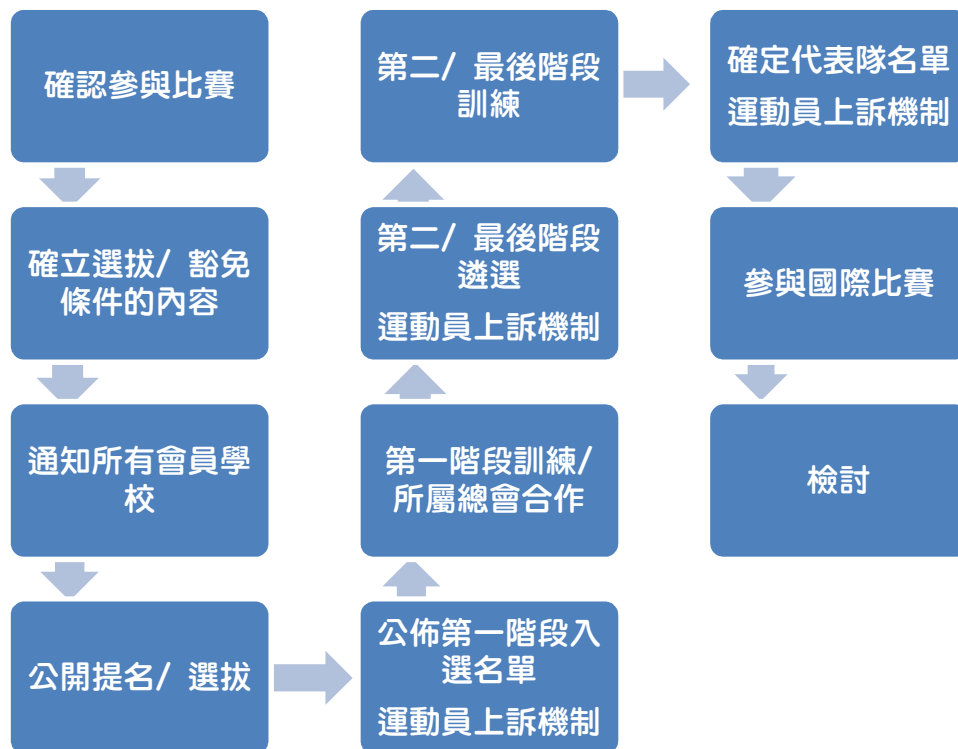
- 2.1 就選拔學界代表隊事宜，聯會設立公平、公開及有效的遴選機制，成立個別體育項目的技術及遴選小組，負責選拔，並訓練學界代表隊參與國際比賽。
- 2.2 技術及遴選小組成員由經驗豐富的體育老師擔任。成員來自自由各分區中、小學及不同界別人士組成。小組更邀請有關體育總會代表為小組成員，擔任總會與聯會之間的橋樑，並為小組提供技術支援。因應個別情況，總會的代表隊教練亦會被邀請擔任香港學界代表隊教練，出席國際賽事。技術及遴選小組成員任期為兩年，由對外體育委員會管理。

3 香港學界代表隊的遴選準則

- 3.1 由個別技術及遴選小組監察，視乎比賽規模而定，學界代表隊的遴選於比賽前三個月至一年前開始。除一般由比賽籌委會所定立的參賽資格：如年齡、性別和國籍外，技術及遴選小組亦為配合康文署撥款機制（居港年滿三年）及個別比賽而制定個別的遴選條件：例如，游泳及田徑項目，會員學校須根據正式通告的指引，透過申報認可成績，推薦運動員參與選拔。
- 3.2 如出現特殊情況，技術及遴選小組將提名 1) 精英比賽的得獎者及 2) 現役各總會青年代表隊隊員參與第一階段的遴選。此訊息將於首次發放選拔通告時一併通知各會員學校。
- 3.3 視乎訓練場地而定，第一階段的訓練將每周進行 1 至 2 次。運動員於每階段訓練後將經過篩選，此程序直至選出最後代表隊為止。
- 3.4 運動員可以透過所屬學校就遴選機制提出意見及上訴，機制如下：
 - 向技術及遴選小組反映，仍不滿意者；

- 向對外體育委員會反映，仍不滿意者；
 - 向中學或小學體育理事會反映，仍不滿意者；
 - 向董事會提出上訴，並以董事會決定為最終決定。
- 3.5 所有上訴程序須根據聯會制定的附例與細則為準。
- 3.6 透過參與埠際、全國中學生運動會及海外學界比賽, 向精英學生運動員提供高水平的訓練及參賽機會。而各體育總會教練可依循各遴選過程觀察，挑選精英運動員，培訓為香港代表隊接班人。
- 3.7 民政事務局和康樂及文化事務署為訓練及比賽的資助機構。

Selection Criteria of Hong Kong Schools Teams
for International Schools Sports Competitions

1. Background

- 1.1 Apart from promoting local schools sports, the Federation is obliged to raise the standard of schools sports and cultivate international friendship by actively participate in Interport, Asian and All China Competitions. Since 1969, Hong Kong School teams have been actively participated in Asian Schools' competitions every year.
- 1.2 The Federation has established a regular Interport competition structure with Guangdong, Fujian and Macau. This annual function will comprise of eight secondary sports (Athletics, Swimming, Cross Country, Basketball, Badminton, Football, Table Tennis & Volleyball) organised two years in a row and each region to host an event and visit the other 3 regions on an annual basis. In addition, Hong Kong has also established another Interport competition with Macau for 2 secondary and 4 primary sports events.
- 1.3 The Federation participates in the All China Secondary Schools Students' Games, which is the most important school games in China held every three years.
- 1.4 The Federation is a member of Asian Schools Football Federation and Asian School Sport Federation and actively participates in Asian Schools Sports Competitions.
- 1.5 The External School Sports Committee is responsible for Interport and International schools sports competitions and related selection procedures.

2. Technical & Selection Committees

- 2.1 The Federation has established a fair, open and effective mechanism in the selection of Hong Kong Schools Representative teams. Respective Technical and Selection Committees will be responsible to look after selection, training and participation.
- 2.2 Members of the Committees are comprised of sports convenors and experienced P. E. teachers with technical and training background. There will be equal representation as far as possible from different Region/Area, Secondary/Primary and gender. Representatives of various National Sports Associations are also

invited to be members of the committees, serving as a bridge between the Federation and National Sports Associations as well as to provide technical advices in the selection and training. In some occasions, coaches of National Sports Associations will be invited to serve as team coaches at International schools competitions. The term of office for members of the Technical and Selection Committees is 2 years and to be confirmed at the External School Sports Committee.

3. Selection Criteria of HK Schools Teams

- 3.1 To prepare a Hong Kong Schools Team, an open, fair and just selection, supervised by the respective Technical and Selection Committees, will be conducted at least from 3 months to 1 year depending on the scale of the competitions or games. Apart from general conditions relating to age, sex and nationality set by Organizing Committees, participation conditions imposed by subvention criteria of the Leisure and Cultural Services Department, (resided in Hong Kong for three years), respective Technical & Selection Committee may set up special tailor made Selection Criteria . For events, such as Swimming and Athletics, selection will be based on nomination with self-reported results. All member schools will be officially informed of the selection or nomination by circular.
- 3.2 The Technical and Selection Committee may impose exemption for first stage selection, such as (i) winners of Jing Ying Competitions, and (ii) current representatives of NSA youth training squad. Any exemption will be announced at the same notice of the selection circular.
- 3.3 The first stage squad training will be conducted once or twice a week pending on the availability of venues. Athletes will then undergo screening process till the final team composition has been confirmed.
- 3.4 An appeal mechanism is set up whereby athletes may raise their views, comments or appeal on the selection via their schools as follows:
 - To the Technical and Selection Committee, if not satisfied;
 - To the External School Sports Committee, if not satisfied;
 - To the Secondary/Primary School Sports Council, if not satisfied;
 - To the Board – the decision shall be final
- 3.5 The procedures and rules as laid down in the By-Laws and Rules of the Federation must be observed when raising appeal to the Federation.

3.6 The participation in Interport, All China and overseas schools competition provide elite student athletes with quality training and competition opportunities at high level. Through the involvement of National Sports Associations in the selection and training, it is able to feed potential athletes to their junior squad. This feeder system works effectively and many elite student athletes have eventually become national sportsperson competing for the glory of Hong Kong.

3.7 Funding of training and competitions are supported by the Home Affairs Bureau and the Leisure and Cultural Services Department.
